Varietal Composition: Syrah

Style: Dry Red

Vineyard: Mountain vineyards of the Estate at an altitude of 600 meters

Soil: Clay-loam

Harvest dates: Hand harvest, end of August.

Vinification: Cold maceration for 3 days followed by classic long-lasting red vinification and maturation

for 18 months in oak barrels. Bottle aging for two years. It may be aged for 10 additional years.

Organoleptic Characteristics: Rich red colour with tobacco highlights.

Nose complex, fruity with notes of spices and dried fruits.

Sturdy, juicy mouth with balanced tannins and elongated aftertaste.

Harmony of Flavors: Hunting, grilled meats, ripe cheeses.

Served at: 16-18°C
